

GERMANTOWN FESTIVAL

SEPTEMBER 9 and 10, 2017

The 46th **Annual Germantown Festival** takes place the weekend after Labor Day on Saturday, September 9, from 9:30 AM until 6 PM and Sunday, September 10, from 12 Noon until 6 PM in Germantown Civic Club Complex, 7745 Poplar Pike, Germantown, TN located just east of the Memphis, TN city limits. Police estimate attendance at more than 50,000 people each year. Admission is free.

Germantown Festival is known as one of the premier Arts & Crafts shows in the South. The main focus is always the Arts and Crafts Market, but we also feature foods provided by local non-profits, rides, games, stage entertainment, car exhibits, community attractions, a limited numbers of commercial vendors, and the Running of the Weenies Dachshund Race.

More than 400 outdoor 10' x 10' arts and crafts vendor spaces are available. Application Fee is \$250. All applications are subject to approval of the Germantown Festival Committee. Photo of the type merchandise to be sold and a self addressed, stamped, business size envelope is required. Very limited numbers of commercial spaces are available. Sale of any food product requires preapproval, a Shelby County Health Department permit and on-site inspection. No unapproved food or drink giveaways are allowed. Electricity is limited. Generators and any open flames are not allowed, but invertors are acceptable to the Fire Marshall. Former participants are given priority. **Vendors supply their own set up equipment including tents, tables, signage, etc.** One parking pass is issued for each space, with additional passes available for \$10 each.

Vendor set up begins at 10:00 AM Friday and continues until opening time on Saturday. **Breakdown cannot begin until after 6:00 closing on Sunday. No Changes of Spaces** allowed without approval. **Only those products listed on applications will be allowed. Violations will be cause for removal from the Germantown Festival with no refund of fees.**

The area is lighted, and overnight police security is provided on Friday and Saturday. Supply trailers can be dropped on the Festival grounds as long as space is available, but **no vehicles are allowed to park inside the park. Vendor Parking is located across the street from the Festival.** RV parking is available on that lot or at the nearby AgriCenter lot, phone number 901-757-7777.

Germantown Festival will not assume any responsibility for damages or loss to persons or of personal belongings, to articles for sale, or to any equipment supplied by a vendor. Each participant is responsible for his own Liability Insurance.

Participating vendors will receive complete information packets including maps, booth and parking assignments, etc. in their **self addressed stamped envelopes** in August.
