

49th Annual GERMANTOWN FESTIVAL

SEPTEMBER 11 and 12, 2021

Physical location is Germantown Civic Club Complex, 7745 Poplar Pike, Germantown, TN 38138

Hours on Saturday are 9:30am to 6pm and Sunday 12 noon until 6pm Always the weekend after Labor Day

Application fee is \$250 for 10x10 outdoor space. Additional \$30 for any food sales or samples.
No unapproved food or drink give away is allowed.

Payment by check, cash, or money order; photo of merchandise; and self addressed stamped business size envelope must be included with application. **Mailing address is Germantown Festival, PO Box 381741, Germantown, TN 38183.** Confirmation of acceptance will be sent following Festival review.

Very few spaces have electrical supply. No generators or open flames are permitted by the Fire Marshall, but invertors are allowed.

Vendors provide all tents, display and set up equipment.

Set up begins Friday, Sept. 10, 10am and runs continuously until 8:30am on Saturday, Sept. 11. Overnight security is provided, but vendors must secure tents and merchandise. Break down cannot begin until after 6pm Sunday.

No change of spaces is allowed. Only those products listed on vendor application are allowed.

One parking pass per booth space is included with registration fee. Additional passes are \$10 each.

Vendor parking is across the street in the New Bethel Church lot. No motor vehicle parking on the Festival grounds after set up time.

RV parking is available at the Church for self contained units, and at nearby Agricenter RV lot (901-757-7777) for units needing hook up service.

Germantown Festival will not assume responsibility for damages or loss to persons, personal belongings, articles for sale or to any vendor supplied equipment. Each participant is responsible for his own Liability Insurance

Violation of rules will be cause for removal and banning from Germantown Festival with no refund of fees.

Participating vendors receive information packets containing booth location, maps, parking pass, etc. in their self addressed return envelope in mid August.

Germantown Festival is known as one of the premier Arts & Crafts shows in the South attracting more than 35,000 people. The focus is always the Arts and Crafts Market, but it also features foods provided by local non-profits, rides, games, stage entertainment, car exhibits, community attractions, a limited number of community and commercial displays, and the Running of the Weenies Dachshund Race. More than 400 outdoor 10' x 10' arts and crafts vendor spaces are available. New vendors are always welcome and encouraged for this great buyers event.
